KEY THOUGHTS & CONSIDERATIONS FOR EVIDENCE-BASED DNP CAPSTONE PROJECTS (Continued)

- The processes to improve patient care and outcomes at the systems levels are as important many times as the outcomes and there is tremendous value in self reflection along the journey as a transformational leader are critical
- Mentorship is essential
- Empowerment is essential
- DNP students must be accountable to stakeholders for achieving the high degree of reliability expected by key stakeholders

Exemplar of an Evidence-Based DNP Capstone Project Facilitating Transformational Leadership in Healthcare Delivery

- Evidence-Based Assessment for Patients Diagnosed with Sleep Apnea
 - * Developed a focused clinical question with key elements using the PICO format
 - * Examined aggregate patient data and outcomes for the target population of surgical patients in the post anesthesia recovery room (PAR)
 - Critically appraised the study results and existing data based research on assessment and management of sleep appnea
 - Changed institutional policy for assessment, screening, and management of patients at high risk for sleep apnea and implications in the PAR

Examples of DNP Student Capstone Projects

These following are examples of projects focusing on transformational leadership and evidence-based practice change at the micro, macro, and meso systems levels in healthcare delivery

DNP Capstone Foci

- Promoting Effective Staffing and Enhancing Personnel Systems
 Enhancing Interprofessional Education and Collaboration
- Participation in an Interprofessional Team Trying to Improve Processes Related to CMS Core Measures for Falls
- Analysis and Evidence-Based Education of Associated Safety-Related Events (i.e. back injuries, needle sticks)
- Examination of the Effectiveness and Outcomes of Transitional Care Communication Within the Healthcare Delivery System
