






# US ELDERLY GROWTH (65 YRS AND OLDER)


- ✓ 47.8 M to double in next 25 years
- ✓ Age 85 yrs and up fastest growing segment












93% OF MEDICARE SPENDING – MULTIPLE CHRONIC CONDITIONS





DESPITE PROVEN BENEFITS OF NPS PROVIDING HBPC, MEDICARE REGULATORY BARRIERS

BARS NPS FROM CERTIFYING OR RECERTIFYING MEDICARE HOME HEALTH

**POLICY WORK:** 

ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES (APRNS)

BE ALLOWED TO CERTIFY PATIENTS FOR MEDICARE PAYMENT OF HOME HEALTH AND HOSPICE SERVICES.

REMOVING THIS BARRIER WOULD BENEFIT CONSUMERS, PHYSICIANS, AND THE HEALTH CARE SYSTEM.
