Dementia is a syndrome

"Neuro-Degenerative Disease"

- Gradual
- Progressive





- Incidence:
 - Estimated 5.8 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's dementia in 2019
 - Estimated 135 million persons with dementia worldwide by 2050
 - Prevalence :
 - Estimated 487,000 new cases of Alzheimer's Dementia will develop in the US in 2019
 - Aging is the greatest risk factor for developing dementia
 - First members of the Baby Boomer generation turned 70 in 2016 !
 - 1 in 10 people aged 65 years or older has Alzheimer's dementia





Implementation of Screening, Diagnosis & Inter-professional Team Management in Primary Care During the Annual Wellness Visit

The Affordable Care Act (2010) requires ALL persons aged 65 & over to be provided with an AWV effective January 1, 2011. (CR 7079)

6 REQUIRED COMPONENTS OF AWV:

✓ Establish PMH & Family History List of all current providers involved in patient's care

✓ Medication Reconciliation

✓ Measurement of an individual's height, weight, BMI, waist circumference as appropriate

✓ Detection of Cognitive Impairment

✓ Depression & Mood Disorder Screen

✓ Review of the individual's Functional Ability and Level of Safety
